- □ Full Day New Slot (6.5 hours)
  - \$7,344 per child
- □ Half Day (2.5 hours) or Improved Slot
  - \$3,672
- Judy Center (Comprehensive Service Model)
  - **\$165,000 per site**

## Future Costs

- Maryland contracted with APA Consulting and Early Childhood Policy Research on a Comprehensive Analysis of PreK
- The study recommends raising the per student cost allocation for FD to approximately \$9,294-\$12,334 for levels 3-5 in Maryland EXCELs
- Under this plan, MD would need

\$506 million - \$675 million to serve 60-80% of MD four year olds (Est. total of 75,455).
