



Estimated Cost of Implementing NIEER's Ten Quality Standards Benchmarks in the Colorado Preschool Program

Assuming the state maintains current proportions of children served in public, private and Head Start locations, the Cost of Preschool Quality and Revenue calculator estimates a per child rate of \$5,695 for children in half-day settings and \$10,403 for children in full-day settings to meet all 10 Benchmarks. This estimate is based on a 40-week program and does not include the cost of child meals, transportation, or public school facilities.
